Use this guide to reference our funding or support for your research work, or when linking work to your ARC role or membership.

- Outputs include papers, press releases, case studies, posters, leaflets/brochures – including any digital versions of these.
- **If you are adding a reference to an output, please also email a copy to arcnenc@cntw.nhs.uk – this will allow us to build a library of outputs that reference the NIHR ARC NENC and help us when it comes to evidencing NIHR ARC NENC work.**

Our name

Our full name is the National Institute for Health and Care Research (NIHR) Applied Research Collaboration (ARC) North East and North Cumbria (NENC).

When using our name in anything written/designed and shared publicly (including events, presentations, briefings etc) please always use the name in full and as shown above, the first time you use it.

If our name is then subsequently used in the same piece, it can be abbreviated to any of the following:

- NIHR Applied Research Collaboration (ARC) North East and North Cumbria (NENC)
- NIHR ARC North East and North Cumbria (NENC)
- NIHR ARC NENC

Please note: NIHR should always come FIRST, followed by Applied Research Collaboration (ARC) followed by our region (North East and North Cumbria).

Please don't:

- Put our region first (e.g. NIHR North East and North Cumbria ARC).
- Miss out the 'and' (e.g. NIHR ARC North East North Cumbria)

Please ensure you include NIHR in the name at all times.
